Bible verse: - Matthew 21:23-32			
<p>"I'll believe it when I see it..." This saying reminds us how important it is to follow through on promises. It can be easy to "talk a big game" or proclaim that we love God. It's another thing to live out those words and do what we say. In this Gospel lesson, Jesus assures us that He has authority to speak with the words of God Himself. He also reminds us that we can rely on Him to do what He promises.</p> <p>Jesus often disagreed with the leaders and teachers of His time. He often used parables to emphasize how to live, and also to explain who He was. In this passage, both of those things happen.
