6 th September 2020	The Lost Sheep	Green	God loves each one of us.

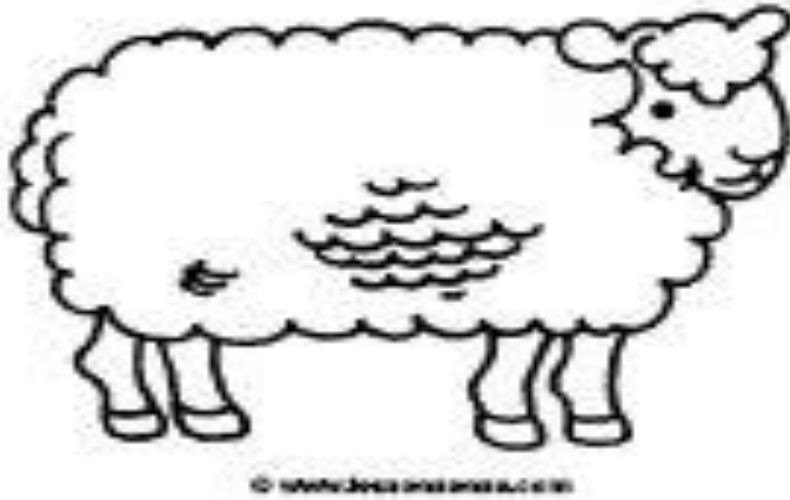
Bible verse:- Matthew 18:10-20

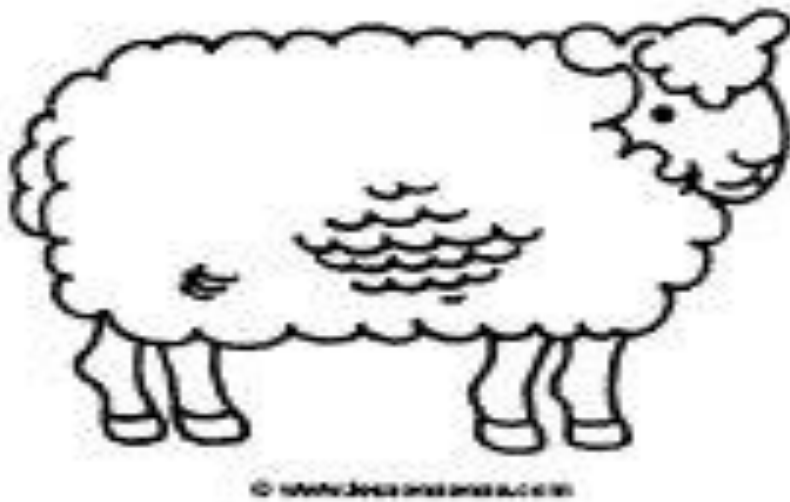

In it we read that should a person for whatever reason forget God and not live in a relationship with God, God will continue to love them and do whatever it takes to reignite the relationship again and when that happens this will make God so happy that he will want to celebrate!

Further Activities

- 1) Watch the Children's Church video for this week. Read the story from the Bible.
- 2) Make a prayer space in a corner of your room (If you haven't already). You could have a little table, on the table put a cross and a candle (a battery operated one would be safest). Make as many copies of the sheep as you'd like to and write the names of the people you know who might especially need to know God's love for them at this time. These might be people who are worried, afraid, sad or don't believe in God. They might be people you love very much and want to say thank you to God for them in this way. You might write your own name because you might want to tell God how much you trust him or need him right now.
