Bible verse: Matthew 14:22-32

Jesus did many amazing things while he walked the earth. Some of these amazing things are called miracles. In this story we heard about Jesus miraculously helping Peter to walk on water just as he was doing. All was going well to begin with wasn't it? Peter was being like Jesus and was walking towards his Friend on water! But what happened? He began to sink didn't he? Why?
